ORDER

Pursuant to Sections 54.1-2919 and 9-6.14:11 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended ("Code"), an informal conference was held with David A. Gilbert, M.D. on Thursday, March 16, 1995, in Richmond, Virginia. Members of the Virginia Board of Medicine ("Board") serving on the informal conference committee ("Committee") were: Thomas A. Wash, M.D., Chairman; Paul M. Spector, D.O.; and Leslie H. Vogt. Dr. Gilbert was present and represented by legal counsel, David Pierce, Esquire. The Board was represented by Grace M. DiLiberto, Assistant Attorney General. The purpose of the informal conference was to review Dr. Gilbert's compliance with the terms and conditions of the indefinite probation imposed upon his license to practice medicine in Virginia pursuant to a Consent Order of the Board dated February 14, 1994.

FINDINGS OF FACT

Now having properly considered the testimony and other evidence presented, the Committee finds by clear and convincing evidence that Dr. Gilbert is in compliance with the terms of the Board's Consent Order dated February 14, 1994.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW


Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact, the Committee concludes that Dr. Gilbert is properly before it, that it is responsible for approving and reviewing all information relative to his compliance with the terms and conditions of the Board's Consent Order dated February 14, 1994, and that it has the discretion to terminate, modify or continue the terms and conditions imposed upon his license.

ORDER

WHEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the indefinite probation imposed upon Dr. Gilbert's license to practice medicine in Virginia is TERMINATED, and he is granted a full and unrestricted license with all attendant rights and privileges.

Pursuant to Section 9-6.14:14 of the Code, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as a public record and shall be made available for public inspection and copying upon request.


